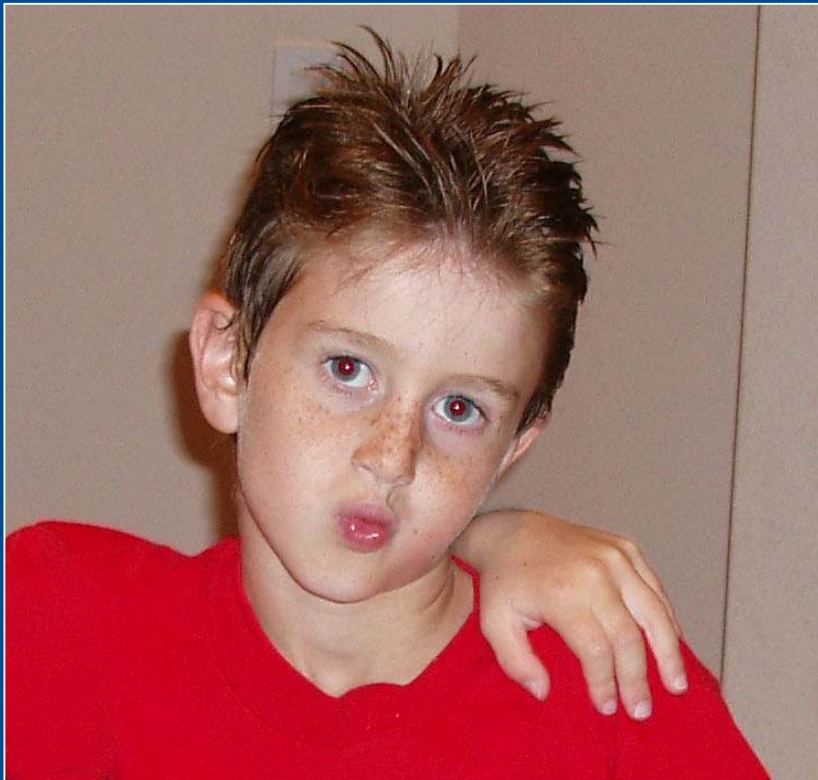

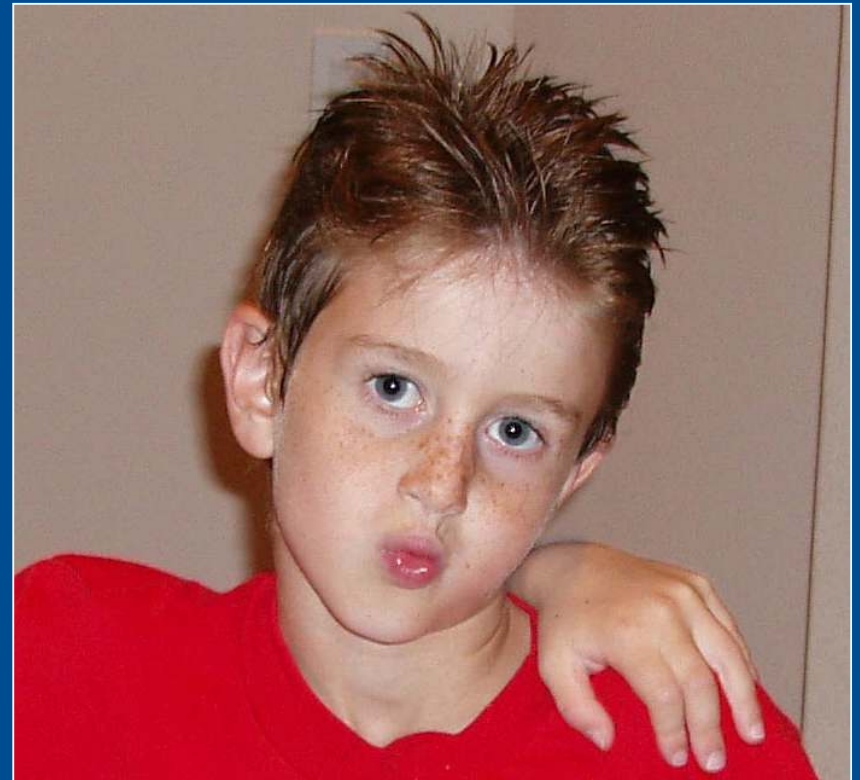

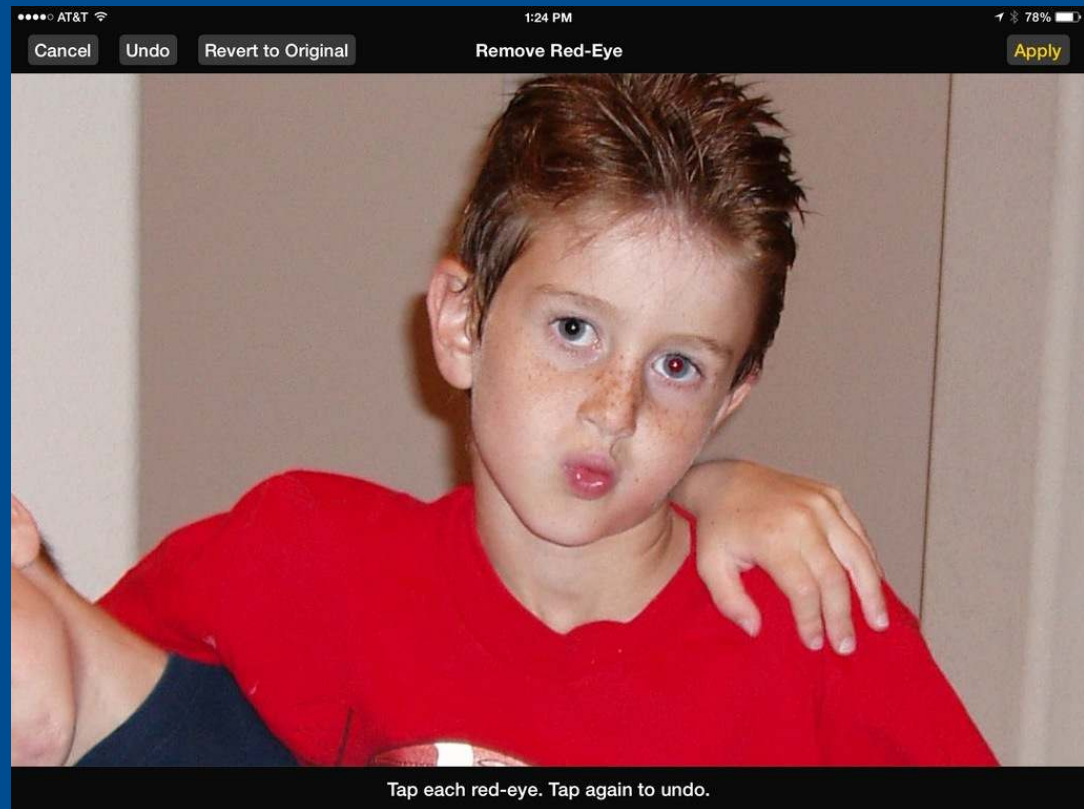


# Photos app

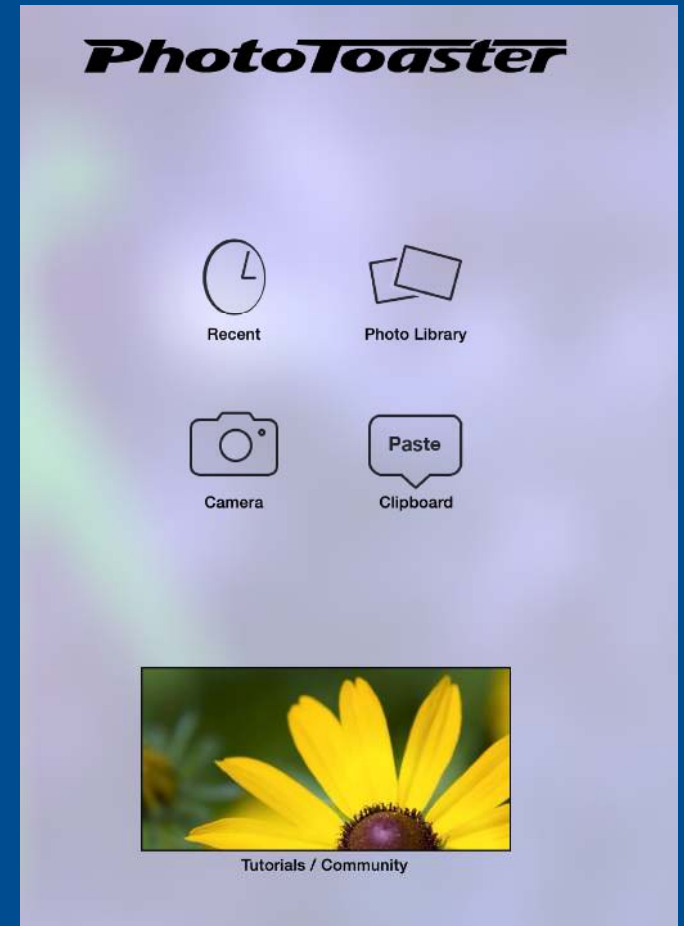

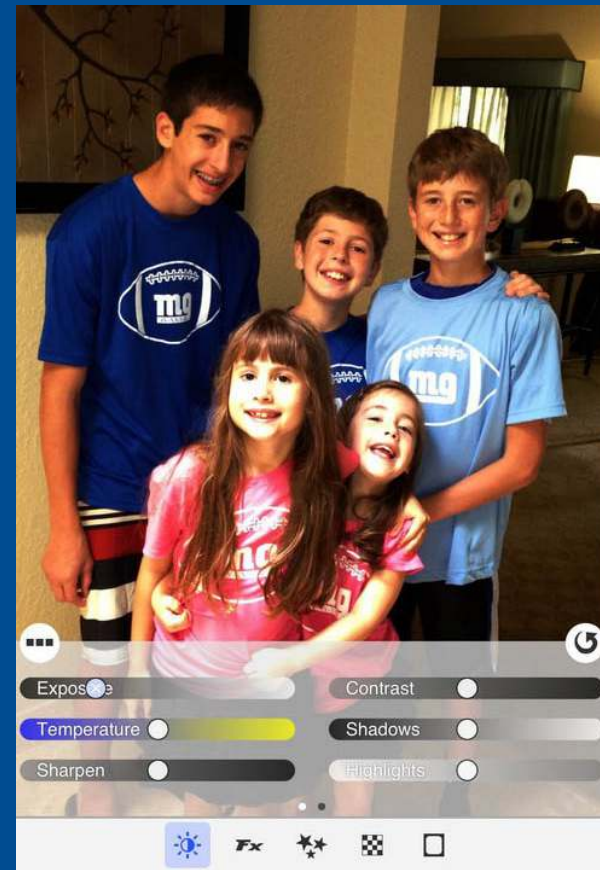

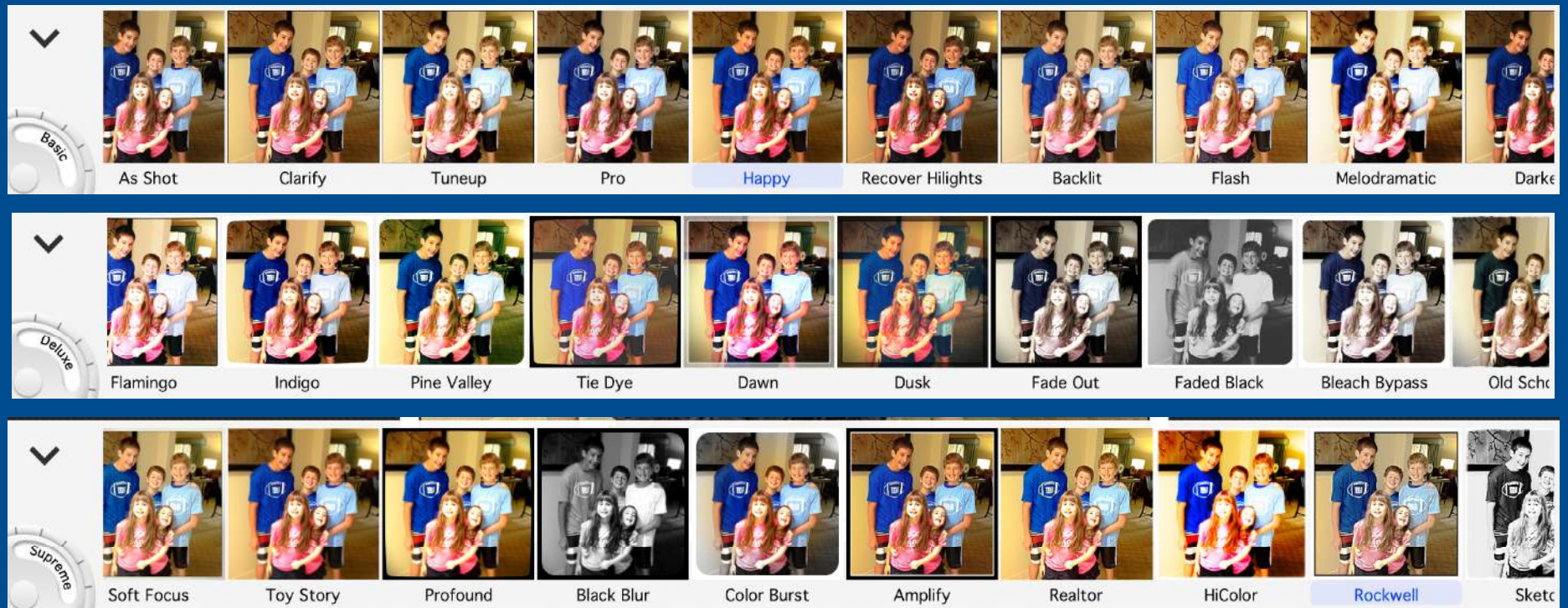
# PhotoToaster

  - Position mask on background, resizing as needed

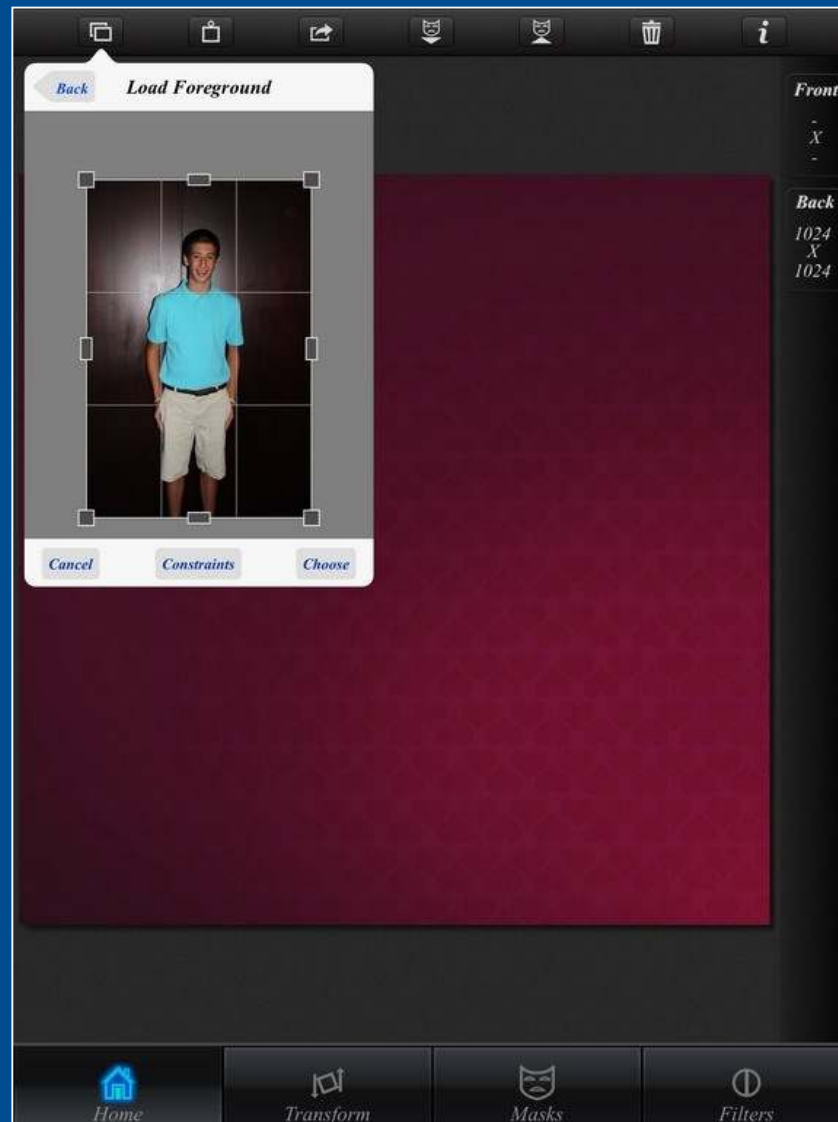
