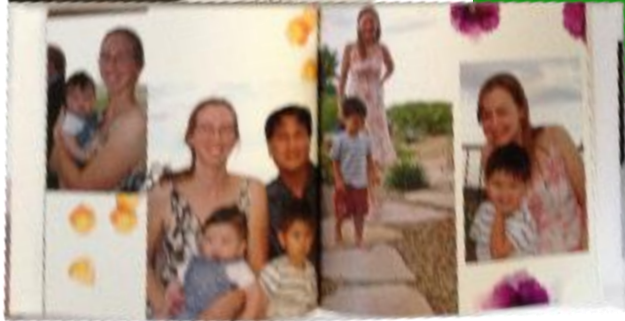

# Computer Based Projects



- Cards
  - Online e-cards or print cards
  - Printed cards using greeting card programs
  - Personally designed cards, newsletters, labels, banners,...
- Self-designed projects printed / produced by an outside company
  - Photo books, calendars, puzzles, photo cards, mugs, blankets,...
- Animated slideshows, personal videos,...
- Self-written e-books and interactive books
- Crafts designed on a computer

# Choosing Online E-card Sites



- When sending e-cards, be sure to select a reputable site, so that you do not accidentally send malware

  - Greeting Card Factory Deluxe by Nova Development (Win)
- Some other programs that can generate cards, fliers, and more:
  - The Print Shop (Mac, Windows)
  - Microsoft Publisher (Windows)
  - Pages (Mac)
  - Microsoft Word (Mac, Windows)

# Graphics and Fonts



- Download only from reputable sites.
- Be aware of the permitted uses for your graphics and fonts.
- Images are tagged with keywords, which helps in searching.
- Clipart and extra fonts are included with some programs, plus font and clip art collections can also be purchased separately
  - Don't load *every* font onto your computer!



# Finding Your Fonts



- Before using fonts, be sure that you have the right to use them in your project
- Many sources for fonts - free, paid, or by subscription
  - boxed or downloaded
    - Included with many programs and operating systems
    - Fontspace - [fontspace.com](https://fontspace.com)
    - Font Squirrel - [fontquirrel.com](https://fontquirrel.com)
    - Adobe Typekit - [typekit.com](https://typekit.com)
      - By subscription
      - Included with Adobe Creative Cloud subscriptions

# Getting Your Graphics



- Before using a graphic, be sure that you have the right to use it in your project
  - Read the licensing agreement to determine permitted uses
  - Just because you found it by Googling, does not necessarily give you rights to use an image as you please
- There is a wide range of images and many come in different resolutions, file types, or as vector images
- Keep a folder of the downloaded images that you have purchased, as well as any receipts or licensing agreements

# Paid Graphics Sites



- There are a number of excellent sites which sell images, clipart, and even stock video footage
  - Not cheap - various pricing plans

  - iStock by Getty- [istockphoto.com](https://istockphoto.com)

# Create Your Own



- Use your own photographs
  - Again a caution if the work will be sold or posted online
  - Edit them for appearance, as well as appropriate resolution for the project
- Create your own graphics
  - Be original and don't just copy someone else's work
  - Even fonts can be designed, but few people actually do

# Write an Interactive Book



- Apple's iBooks Author is a free download for Mac users from Apple's App store
  - Use it to create beautiful books from a template or design your own
  - Add multimedia and interactive elements
  - Many ways to output and read final product
    - Publish to Apple's iBooks Store
    - Output as an iBook to be read on an iOS device or computer
    - Output as a pdf either to be read on a computer, tablet or smart phone, or to be printed
  - Adobe InDesign is a professional solution for print and interactive book creation



# Photo Prep Tips



- Choose clear in focus pictures.
- Pictures should be at least 300 dpi and a suitable size for the project.
- Pictures need to be straight and well lit.
- Crop images appropriately.



# Photo & Video Editing Programs



- **Free** - each is of these is either originally included with a new computer or available as a free download.
  - Photos, iMovie, Pages (Mac) – originally included with a new Mac and also available in iCloud
  - Windows Movie Maker
  - Picasa (Mac, Windows, Linux)
  - Gimp (Mac, Windows, Linux)

# Desktop Publishing Programs



- These are great for producing newsletters, brochures, labels, postcards, ...
  - Microsoft Publisher (Windows)
    - Great for all sorts of desktop publishing projects, as well as being able to handle oversized items, such as posters
  - Pages (Mac)
    - Great for many types of publishing projects on a Mac
  - The Print Shop (Mac, Windows)
  - Microsoft Word (Mac, Windows)

# Animated Slideshows



- You not only will need a group of your pictures; you will also need some music
- Use the mp3 format for the music to help keep file size down
- If uploading to sites like YouTube, you have to have original or royalty free music
  - There are programs that will let you easily create your own soundtracks
    - Apple's Garage Band, Sony's Acid Music Studio, Adobe Premiere Elements
    - You can also add narration

# Programs for Slideshows



- Adobe Photoshop Elements (Mac, Windows)
  - For additional DVD creation features, use the Adobe Photoshop Elements / Premiere Elements bundle.
- Adobe Lightroom (Mac, Windows) which is sometimes used in combination with Photoshop
- Photos app, which replaced iPhoto (Mac)
- Windows Movie Maker
- Picasa (Mac, Windows, and Linux)

# Computer Inspired Projects



- Pinterest [pinterest.com](https://www.pinterest.com) is a site for those interested in crafts and projects
  - Full of ideas with lots of color pictures
  - Some people sell patterns and kits
  - You pin items of interest
  - Pinterest e-mails suggestions based on what you've already pinned
- Design your own

# Designing on a Computer



- Beyond specialized programs for project design, such as CAD and embroidery programs, patterns can be designed and printed with your computer.
- Using a graphics program such as Photoshop Elements or Photoshop, which have layers, a project can be designed and patterns printed out.
- If you plan to make items for each grandchild over a period of time, consider saving all the upper and lower letters in the desired font and size on different layers in a program like Photoshop Elements.
  - Also save as jpg files, since original fonts can be lost

# Printing Oversized Patterns



- Use Microsoft Publisher, which can print a large object on multiple pages, which can then be taped together
- Take a jpg file of the object to a place such as Kinko's, which can print it on a single piece of large paper, using a specialty printer.
