Why Build Techboomers.com?

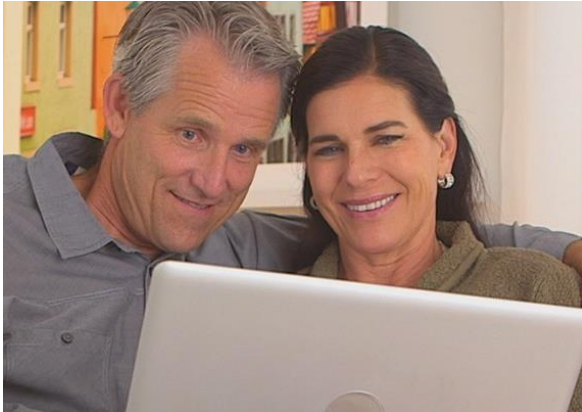
Idea came from teaching my parents how to use websites
