While touring the country by motorhome, Jim and Chris have presented technology seminars along the way.

This presentation was on Google Photos. All your pictures, from CDs, mobiles, tablets, etc., can be organized in the same place. You can safely back up all photos for free online. You can store all pictures on the cloud for unlimited storage. You upload to the cloud - and download to the computer.

Once all your pictures are in the cloud, you can see them from any device, edit them, delete them, make collages, and share them. You can organize them in albums by date, subject, people, etc. This works the same for iPhones and Android phones.

You can edit the photos right on the phone. If you lose or break your phone, all your pictures are still in the cloud.

To get photos from your computer, go to www.photos.google.com/apps. Click on Desktop uploader. You can see all your photos from any computer as long as you have a Google account number and I.D.

With Google Photos, you can also make animations and movies complete with music. All this is free on your computer, smartphone or tablet.
