SUMMARY

 You can use various models of Webcams to spy on your home(s), business(es), and pets. They can alert your cell phone and/or your computer when they detect motion.

 In addition to these basic functions, the Internet cloud can now provide you with:

A means of communicating with a Webcam from points unknown

and

WEBCAM BASICS

According to https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Webcam
 <start of quote>

A webcam is a video camera that feeds or streams its image in real time to or through a computer to (a) computer network.

When "captured" by the computer, the video stream may be saved, viewed or sent on to other networks via systems such as the internet, and email as an attachment.

<end of quote>

WEBCAM BASICS (continued)

- The term "Webcam" is sometimes used for wired USBconnected cameras only.
- It is more commonly used to refer to wired USB-connected cameras, wired IP cameras (IP=Internet Protocol), Wi-Fi cameras (which require an AC power outlet), and totally-wireless Wi-Fi cameras.



HISTORY OF WEBCAMS

- 1994: Connectix's "Quickcam" for Macintosh (serial port and parallel port models).
 - The very first model had a "mini DIN" serial plug:





Pair of female Mini DIN-8 connectors used for RS-422 serial ports on a Macintosh LC computer

HISTORY OF WEBCAMS (continued)

- 1996: Wired IP Webcams with a Cat 5 jack
- 1998: Logitech's "Quickcam Home" and "Quickcam Pro" (USB 1 and parallel port models)
- 2000: Webcams integral to laptops and some monitors
- 2001: Webcams with a wired USB 2 cable
- 2005: Wi-Fi wireless cameras

HISTORY OF WEBCAMS (continued)

- 2006: HD Webcams (HD = "High definition")
- 2012: "Drop Cam" Wi-Fi Internet Webcam
- 2014: "Drop Cam" evolved into "Nest Cam"
- 2015: Netgear "Arlo" (first battery-powered, totallywireless camera)

LEGAL ISSUES REGARDING WEBCAMS

Legalities for you to be aware of:

 Most Federal and state laws regarding video surveillance pertain to recording audio, so a Webcam that does not record audio may be safer for you to use from a legal standpoint

Legalities for you to be aware of (continued):

- Every state of the U.S.A. and every country has different laws pertaining to the use of Web cams
- "Reasonable expectation of privacy" is a legal precedent that keeps lawyers employed
- Different laws apply to hidden cameras versus cameras that are in plain sight

 Camfecting... is the fraudulent process of attempting to hack into a person's webcam and activate it without the webcam owner's permission. The remotely activated webcam can be used to watch anything within the webcam's field of vision...

SECURITY ISSUES REGARDING WEBCAMS (continued)

Hacker attacks on Web cams (continued):

 According to <u>https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Remote_administration_soft</u> ware

"A remote administration tool (RAT) is a piece of software that allows a remote "operator" to control a system as if he has physical access to that system." One of the results of using a "RAT" might be screen/camera capture or image control.."


SECURITY ISSUES REGARDING WEBCAMS (continued)

Hacker attacks on Web cams (continued):

 A two-router "Demilitarized Zone" is an effective way to block "camfecting" and "RAT" hacks.



SECURITY ISSUES REGARDING WEBCAMS (continued)

Hacker attacks on Web cams (continued):

To protect against Camfecting and Remote
 Administration Tool (RAT) attacks from hackers on the
 Internet, you can connect a Webcam to a computer or a
 router in the DMZ area of a two-router DMZ
 configuration.



WIRED USB WEBCAMS

- Most "Wired USB Webcams" have a USB 2 cable that must be connected to a USB 2 or USB 3 port of a computer
- Only a few models of super-expensive Webcams have a USB 3 cable that must be connected to a USB 3 port of a computer

Your computer

Webcamfriendly app USB cable transmits video to the computer

USB cable provides DC power to the Webcam

Wired USB Webcam



WIRED USB WEBCAMS (continued)

- "Wired USB Webcams" get DC power from their USB 2 or USB 3 cable (so they do not require a separate AC power adapter)
- 16.4 feet (5 meter) limitation for "USB 2" cables
- Active (powered) USB extension cables do not work with wired USB webcams
- This means that the distance between your computer and a wired USB Webcam is limited to 16.4 feet

WIRED USB WEBCAMS (continued)

 "Wired USB Webcams" are the only type of Webcan that work with online meeting services such "Skype", "Adobe Connect", "zoom.us", "appear.in", "Face Time", etc. The other types of Webcams (Wi-Fi Webcams, cloudbased Webcams, and the "Arlo" Webcam) do not work with online meeting services, at the present time.

FREE MOTION DETECTION ALARM USING A WIRED USB WEBCAM

 If you install (or already have) a Webcam and you install the free "ContaCam" or "Yawcam" software programs into your "Windows.." computer, you can use the "Simple Mail Transfer Protocol" (SMTP) server of your email service to have "ContaCam" send photos of motion detection events (intruders, wildlife, authorized personal, etc.) to your cell phone or laptop.

FREE MOTION DETECTION ALARM USING A WIRED USB WEBCAM (continued)

Here is how it works:

- A moving person, object, or animal triggers the motion sensing function of the "ContaCam" or "Yawcam" program in your "Windows.." computer.
- The "ContaCam" or "Yawcam" program begins recording still photographs and/or a video of the "motion detection" events.

FREE MOTION DETECTION ALARM USING A WIRED USB WEBCAM (continued)

Here is how it works (continued):

 The "ContaCam" or "Yawcam" program stores these recordings as files onto a local hard drive that is part of your "Windows.." computer.

FREE MOTION DETECTION ALARM USING A WIRED USB WEBCAM (continued)

Here is how it works (continued):

- The "ContaCam" or "Yawcam" program immediately sends emails to any or all email accounts that you have including the ones that are inside your cellular phone or tablet device.
- You view the photos or video file attachments to determine what to do about the situation.



WI-FI WEBCAMS


- Wi-Fi Webcams communicate wirelessly with your computer through your existing wireless Wi-Fi router
- Wi-Fi Webcams have a separate an AC power adapter which requires a 110-volt AC power outlet.

 To use a Wi-Fi Webcam, you have to use a supported Web browser and you have to install the Webcam manufacturer's Adobe Flash-based browser add-on software to make the Webcam work with the supported Web browser.

- These highly-proprietary restrictions severely limit which Web browser and which operating system will work with a specific model of Wi-Fi Webcam.
- All four of Wi-Fi Webcams that we tested would only communicate with one of the browsers that we attempted to access them with.

- We tested four Wi-Fi Webcams during May through October of 2015:
 - ✓ Trendnet model TV-IP572WI_A
 - ✓ RF-Link model VMI-1201
 - ✓ D-Link model DCS-932L
 - ✓ D-Link model DCS-1130

 Out of the box, only the RF-Link model VMI-1201
 Webcam could be configured by its configuration software without a firmware upgrade from the manufacturer

- The other three cameras would not work with their manufacturer's bundled/downloadable configuration software programs until we ran updated their firmware with their manufacturer's downloadable firmware updater:
 - ✓ Trendnet model TV-IP572WI_A
 - ✓ D-Link model DCS-932L
 - ✓ D-Link model DCS-1130

- Technical hurdles of Wi-Fi Webcams:
 - Rapid firmware obsolescence (sold to you with old firmware)
 - Many browsers not supported by a specific Webcam
 - As new models are released, (initially) they usually lack software support by third-party software such as the free "Contacam"
 - Require AC power outlet for a power adapter (hard to hide)

Trendnet model TV-IP572WI_A notes:

 This Webcam records a video stream that is jerky and appeared to be missing a lot of frames in our Windows 8.1, Windows 10, Mac OS X 10.10, and Mac OS X 10.11 computers.

Trendnet model TV-IP572WI_A notes (continued):

- Out of the retail box, this Webcam did not work until we used a "Windows 8.1" computer to download and install a firmware update from the Trendnet Web site.
- This firmware update was only available in a "Windows.." format so Mac OS X 10.10 and OS X 10.11 users would be unable to update the firmware of this "Webcam".

Trendnet model TV-IP572WI_A notes (continued):

- Trendnet's setup program for this Webcam is only available for "Windows.." computers so Mac OS X 10.10 and 10.11 users are out of luck for a second "gotcha".
- This means that Mac computer users would have to run Windows 8.1 or Windows 10 in a "Boot Camp" partition or in a Parallels or VMware Fusion "Virtual Machine" in order to perform the initial setup of this Webcam.

Trendnet model TV-IP572WI_A notes (continued):

- Once we struggled through the firmware and initial setup of the Web, it worked okay in both Macs and PCs.
- In a "Windows 7", "Windows 8.1", or "Windows 10", Mac OS X 10.10, or Mac OS X 10.11 computer, the video that is displayed in a Web browser or that is recorded is jerky and appears to be missing a lot of frames.

Trendnet model TV-IP572WI_A notes (continued):


 In "Windows 8.1" and "Windows 10, the Internet Explorer 11 browser is able to display and record the video stream but the Chrome browser is unable to do so.

Trendnet model TV-IP572WI_A notes (continued):

 In our Macs running OS X 10.10 Yosemite and OS X 10.11 El Capitan, both the Safari and Firefox browsers were able to display and record video streams. However, the Chrome browser was unable to do so.





 In a "Windows 8.1" or a "Windows 10" computer, the Web page that is accessed by "Internet Explorer 11" shows a video stream that looks like this:



 In a "Windows 8.1" or a "Windows 10" computer, when we use the Chrome browser to access the Web page that is generated by this Webcam, we get repeated notices to download the "NCS Plugin" which failed to install:





Click here to download NCSPlugin and install.

The Chrome browser does not support NPAPI plug-ins and therefore will not run all Java content. Switch to a different browser (Firefox, Internet Explorer or Safari on Mac) to run the Java plug-in. More info


- This is the only Wi-Fi Webcam (of the four that we tested) that did not require a firmware update prior to initial configuration.
- We were unable to get this Webcam to work with a Mac running OS X 10.10 or OS X 10.11. We failed to access this Webcam with the Safari, Chrome, and Firefox Web browsers in OS X 10.10 or OS X 10.11

RF-Link model VMI-1201 notes (continued):

 In a Windows 8.1 or a Windows 10 PC, we were were able to get this Webcam working with the Internet Explorer browser but we were unable to get it working with a Chrome browser.

RF-Link model VMI-1201 notes (continued):


 When we used "Internet Explorer 11" in a Windows 8.1 or a Windows 10 computer, the video stream on this Webcam's Web page looked like this:





RF-Link model VMI-1201 notes (continued):

 When we used the Chrome browser in a Windows 8.1 or a Windows 10 computer, we got this:










RF-Link model VMI-1201 notes (continued):

- In a Mac running OS X 10.10 or OS X 10.11, we were unable to access the video stream in the Web page that is generated by this Webcam.
 - We failed with the all three of the Web browsers that we tried: the Safari browser, the Chrome browser, and the Firefox browser:







RF-Link model VMI-1201 notes (continued):

- In a PC running Windows 8.1 or Windows 10, go to "http://videolan.org" and install the 32-bit version of "VLC Media Player.
- After you do so, "Internet Explorer.." will be able to access the video stream of this Webcam. For an unknown reason, the Chrome browser will still be unable to access the video stream of this Webcam

RF-Link model VMI-1201 notes (continued):

- In a PC running Windows 8.1 or Windows 10, if you install or have already installed the default 64-bit version of the free "VLC Media Player" program, then both the "Internet Explorer.." and Chrome browsers will be unable to access the video stream of this Webcam.
- If you find the 64-bit "VLC Media Player" program inside the PC, remove it.

D-Link model DCS-932L:

 At \$40, this Webcam was the cheapest one that we attempted to install and it was a total failure in our Windows 8.1, Windows 10, Mac OS X 10.10, and Mac OS X 10.11 computers:



D-Link model DCS-932L notes:

 This Webcam firmware update (that we downloaded from the D-Link Web site) before we were able to perform the initial configuration setup.

D-Link model DCS-932L notes (continued):

 However, after the initial configuration of this Webcam in a "Windows.." computer, this Webcam failed to display video in both of "Windows.." PCs and it also failed to work in our Macs running OS X 10.10 and OS X 10.11

D-Link model DCS-932L notes (continued):

- No Mac OS X support:
- For OS X, configuration software link at the D-Link Web sites fails to download a configuration utility (= dead hyperlink)
- After we used a "Windows.." PC to configure this Webcam, the Safari and Chrome Web browsers in our Mac OS X 10.10 computer failed to display the video of this Webcam (but so did our "Windows" computers).

D-Link model DCS-932L notes (continued):

- For Windows 7 or 8.1 or 10, configuration software works but the resultant web page does not show live video.
- When you use IE10 or Chrome browsers in a Windows 7 or 8.1 or 10 computer to view the video stream since It locks up after the first frame.

D-Link model DCS-1130 notes:

 We had better success with this \$119 Webcam which is also from the D-Link company:

- Required a firmware update (that we downloaded from the D-Link Web site) before we were able to perform the initial configuration setup.
- All had bundled users manuals and documentation of these three Webcams that showed screen shots of "Windows 7" screens.


D-Link model DCS-1130 notes (continued):


 After it's firmware was updated, the dcs-1130 worked well in the Chrome browser in "Windows 8.1" and "Windows 10".

It never worked in "Internet Explorer 11" in "Windows 8.1" or "Windows 10".

D-Link model DCS-1130 notes (continued):

 After it's firmware was updated, DCS-932L worked in and the "Chrome browser" in "Windows 8.1" and "Windows 10":





D-Link model DCS-1130 notes (continued):
