PUSH Articles for Your Newsletter

- The PUSH article e-mail includes a short description of the articles and, as requested by editors, word count.
- Editors who have 10-12 page newsletters have a quick way to select short articles or other editors to select a short article for to fill a space in their newsletter, etc.
- Articles are uploaded to group websites
- Link to the .zip file on group's website
- Editors use one or two articles in their newsletter
- Newsletters are all PUSH articles
