Contest Rules

- Photographers who won in 2016 are not eligible to enter the 2018 contest
- The contest begins on August 15 and ends September 30
- One photo may be entered in each of four categories
- Entries are to be submitted via e-mail in .jpg format, not to exceed 4MB each
- Each entry will receive an acknowledgement e-mail
- Entries can be color or black and white
- Light editing is allowed
- Entrants will be judged for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place under the below criteria

Categories

- A. People
- B. Animals
- C. Landscape
- D. Architecture Urban design, cityscapes, & landmarks

Judging Criteria

- Composition (5 points)
- Technical Skill (5 points)
- Visual Impact (10 points)

All entries must have an e-mail date stamp no later than September 30, 2018.

**Include the following information in the body of each e-mail (one photo per e-mail):

- Category and name of photo
- Your name and e-mail address
- Name of group
- Name of president and e-mail address

**Please save your photos using the following format: category_lastnamefirstname_usergroup intitials_picture name.
