Track 3 – Raising Your Hand Chat Box / Android / iOS

• You can also ask questions and make comments via the Chat Box.

- If you don't have video or choose not to use it...
- Click on the *Participants* button and click on *Raise your Hand* (Windows, Mac & Linux)
- Android Tap Participants and Raise Hand
- iOS Tap 2 dots (middle bottom)>Tap 3 dots/Menu>Tap *Raise Hand*
- The moderator will see the digital raised hand and call on you
