PUBLIC RECORDS

- ➤ Census records 72 years (law)
- ➤ Birth certificates 105 years
- ➤ Death certificates 50 years
- ➤ Marriage licenses; wills
- > Newspapers
- > History (including family) books

LIMITATIONS OF DIGITIZED COLLECTIONS

- In order to search (usually pdf), scanning must have been OCR and clear copy
- > Search function only as good as copy is
- Many google e-books scanned as images!
 Cannot be searched

DIGITIZED COLLECTIONS

- Usually indexed by machine
- > Use CREATIVE searching
- ➤ Use wild card *
- > Narrow by date, place, if possible
- > Add keyword where appropriate
- "First Last" name

CREATIVE SEARCHING

- > Adams County, PA + cemetery records
- > Thompson Boyle + genealogy
- ➤ John Bowser + Mary Helm + genealogy
- Margaret Anderson + obituary
- Ohio + free + death records

LIBRARY RESOURCES

- University libraries
- > Local city/county libraries
- County library where ancestors settled
- Microfilmed newspapers
- > Local indexes

LIBRARIES COULD HAVE

- > County marriage index
- > Newspaper obituary index
- > Cemetery index
- > Marriage index
- ➤ Local/regional, genealogy links


ONLINE SEARCHES

- > If using an index, start with
 - ✓ Surname only
 - √ No date
- > Call library, talk to genealogist
 - ✓ May have resource room
 - ✓ Surname files
 - ✓ Business, company files

- > Full text downloadable (pdf)
- > Census records
- County history books
- > Family history books
- > Some state indices



HERITAGEQUEST

- > Online, free with library card
- > Family, lineage, and local histories
- ➤ Books (even in copyright)
- Owned by ancestry
- Download/view books one page at a time

NEWSPAPERS - BIRTH

- > Birth announcement
- Birthday parties
 - ✓ Age
 - ✓ Attendees (parent, grandparent, sibling names)
- > High school/college graduation
- > Join military

NEWSPAPERS - MARRIAGE

- Marriage license application
- > Engagement announcement
- > Wedding
- Anniversary celebration (names of children)
- > Years ago features

NEWSPAPERS - DEATH

- ➤ Dates of death, burial information, and even cause of death
- ➤ Obituaries around since 1800s
- Standard practice beginning end of 19th century
- > Estate sales, executor, death notices
- > Post-funeral thank you notices

SEARCH TIPS

- Search local newspaper and surrounding area newspapers
- > Before estimated death date
- Funeral articles (pall bearers, church affiliation)
- > Several months following death
- Search for death of spouse and/or siblings

OBITUARY LIMITATIONS

- Information in obituaries, death certificates usually provided by survivors
- > Information may not be accurate
- Add updated/corrected information in brackets to a typed copy of original and include original with typed copy

ACCIDENTS

- National news
- Search for accident details/features
